## Project aims

- Setting out a pathway to restoration of **England's peatland habitats**
- Ambition: **280,000ha** of restoration delivery by **2050**
- Supports **England Peat Action Plan** and **Net Zero Strategy**
- Developing an **evidence-based Roadmap** which helps the sector deliver
- Commissioning stakeholder research to **build a shared delivery pipeline**
- Collaborating on **definitions of restoration** and **trajectories to recovery**

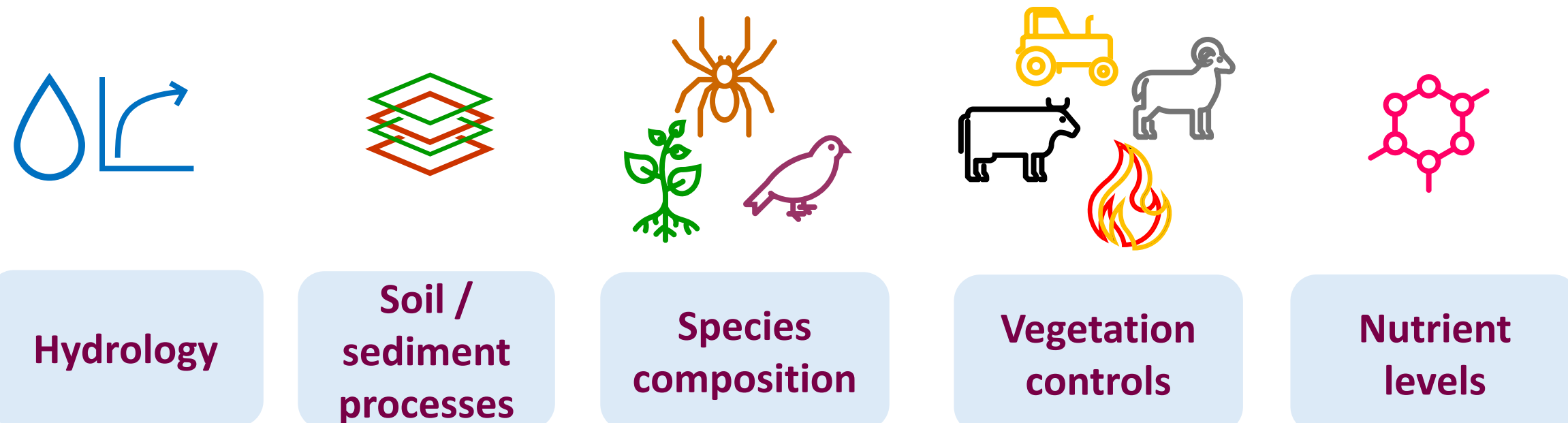

- Technical Advisory Group and Project Steering Group partners have **agreed a consistent approach** for forecasting hectares of restoration in the Roadmap:

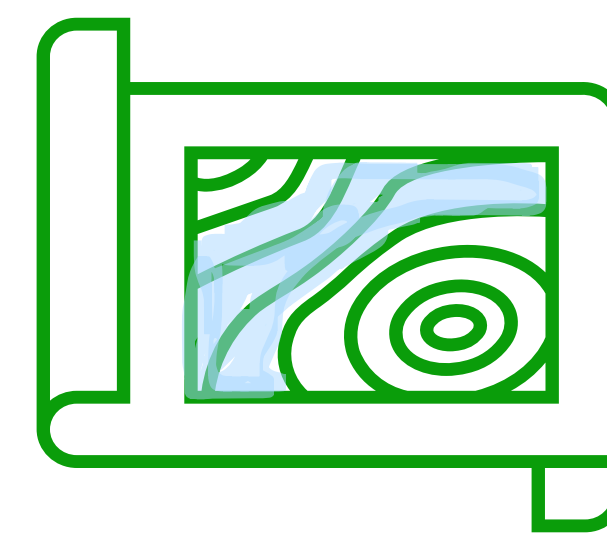
### 1. Types of restoration action

Based on aspects of natural function<sup>1</sup>



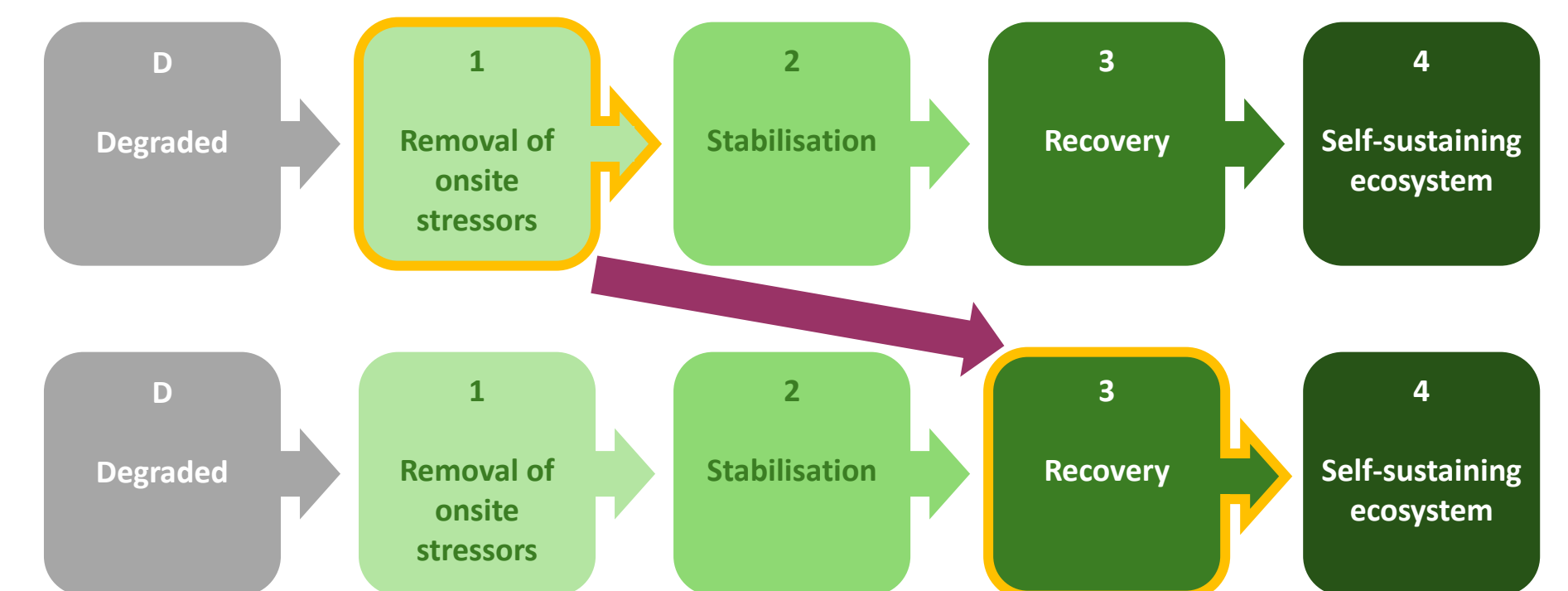
### 2. Area of restoration

Based on area of hydrological influence



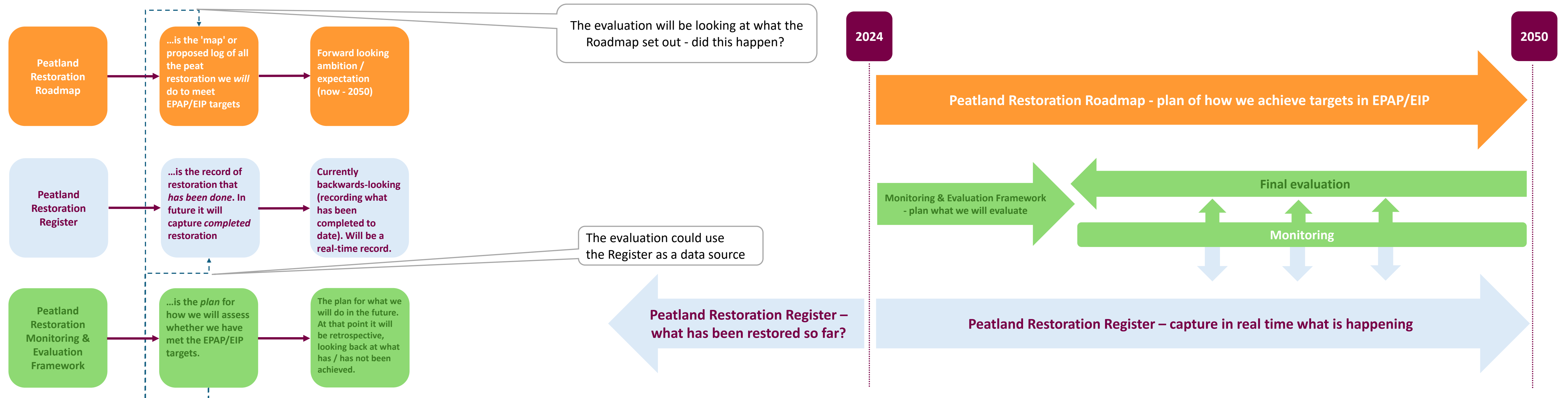
### 3. Stages of progress
