

Peatland Code Accreditation

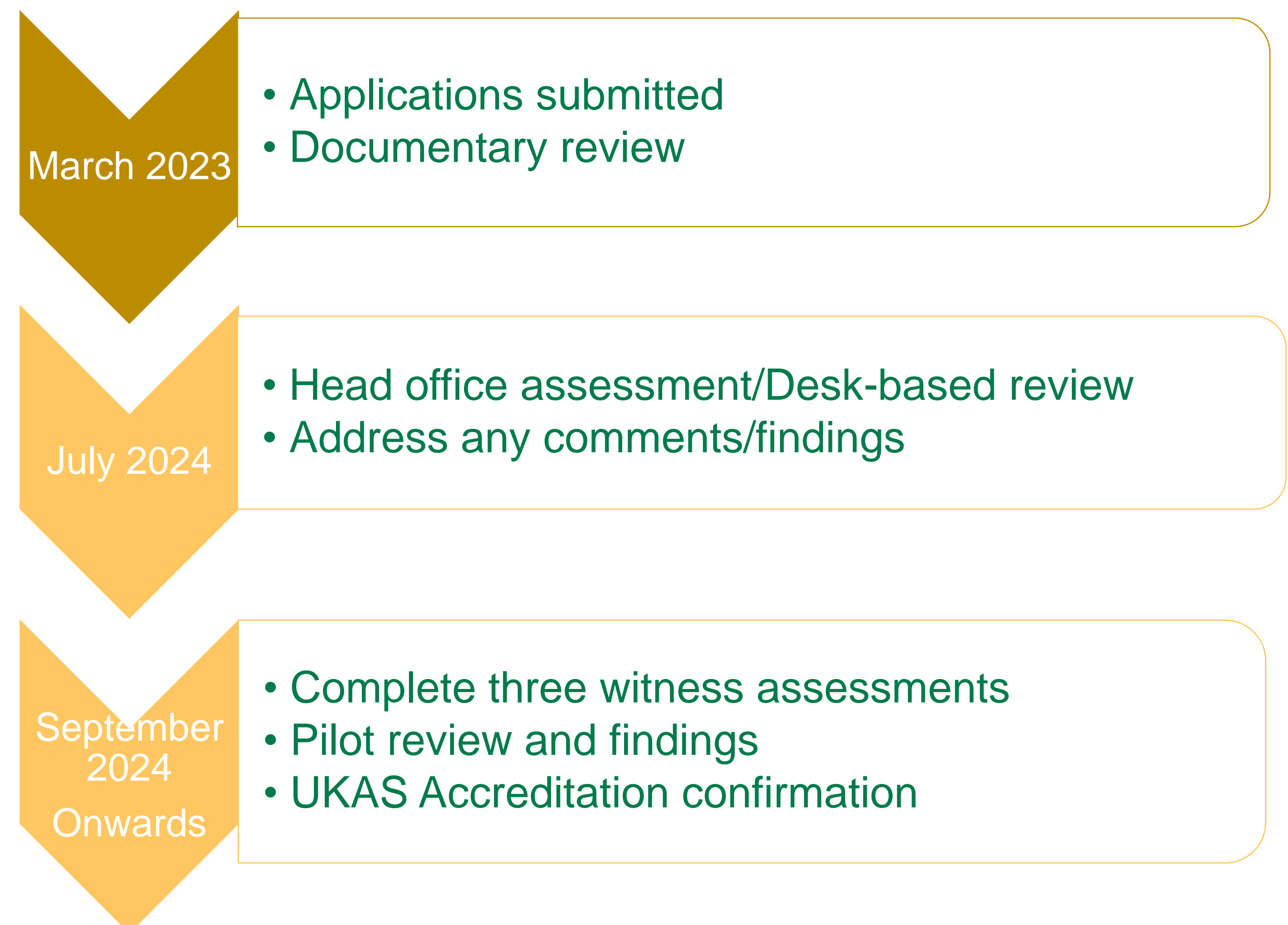


Accreditation is key aspect of our work. It serves as a demonstration of our adherence to international standards and best practices, and it provides assurance to stakeholders that our operations are credible and reliable.

First part is for Peatland Code (PC) validation and verification bodies (VVBs) to receive United Kingdom Accreditation Services (UKAS) accreditation to the relevant ISO standards for the PC. Two of our VVBs are well underway with the accreditation and the aim is that these VVBs will be accredited by **January 2025**.

The second part is achieving international certification against ICROA and ICVCM Core Carbon Principles for the IUCN UK Programme and Peatland Code.



Work is underway to apply for ICVCM CCP approval in early 2025.
